intruder – a person who comes in without permission

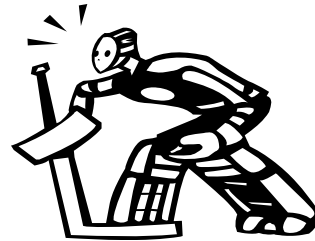
ruthless – harsh or cruel
