donate – to give without expecting anything back

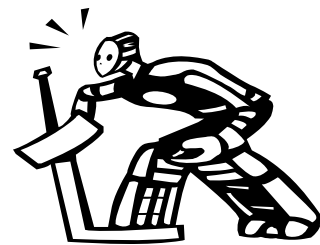
don – to put on, dress
