**consecutive** – one right after the other

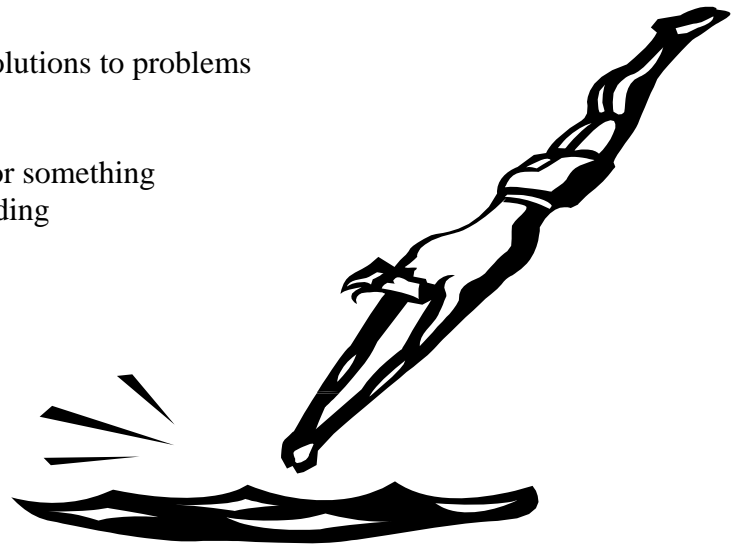
**engineer** – person who creates or designs solutions to problems
