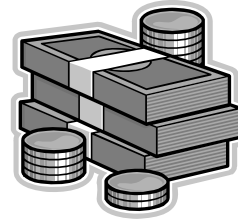

## “What’s this bailout buzz”

**bailout** – helping a person or company out of a financial crisis by giving them more money

**U.S. Treasury Department** – the government agency responsible for printing money, collecting taxes, and other financial duties

**Fannie Mae** – Federal National Mortgage Association (FNMA) a government-sponsored lending institute that helps banks provide loans

**Freddie Mac** – Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation (FHLMC) a partner government-sponsored lending institute that helps banks provide loans

**credit** – getting something now with a promise to pay for it later

**loan** – letting someone borrow something and expecting them to pay back

**stock market** – buying and selling stocks and bonds, which are small shares of companies

**vicious** – dangerous and violent

**jump start** – giving a boost to get something going

**economy** – the money system of a country or state

**resolve** – a strong determination

**bust** – bad business times
