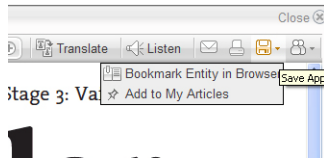


Marking Articles in The Denver Post eEdition

The eEdition was just upgraded and now you can “mark” articles for your students to retrieve at a later date. Since articles are saved server-side, anyone using your login information will be able to see the articles you have saved, from any computer. This will be a great way for you to create folders, either by topic or weekly assignment, with articles you want to make sure your students read.

First double-click the article to open it in Article View (in a separate window), then click Save (the disc icon) >Add to My Articles.



You create the categories, based on your needs. When adding a new article, you can create a new category tag or mark it with a category you have already created. In the comments section, you can make a student assignment.



When viewing My Articles, you can switch to the edit mode to edit/delete an article, comment and or category.
